Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas County continues to partner with our community to provide affordable housing solutions to low & moderate income families. Over the past four years, Habitat Pinellas has grown at a record pace, now building more than 55 new homes annually.

We were recently made aware by Charity Navigator that our 4-Star Rating will be decreased to a 3-Star Rating. Charity Navigator states they rate charities by evaluating two broad areas of performance; Financial Health and Accountability & Transparency. We are proud to share that Habitat Pinellas' annual audit has received no internal control or compliance findings in more than 10 years. Our finance committee and Board of Directors continues to provide guidance & expertise that has led to the organization having the strongest balance sheet in the history of the affiliate.
